R.E.L. (Bobby) Krick, Historian at Richmond National Battlefield Park and author of *Staff Officers In Gray*, among other works.

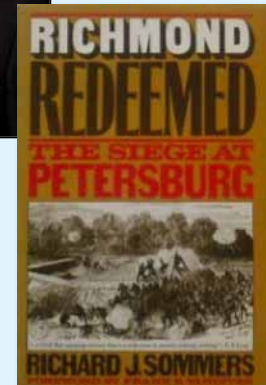


Gordon Rhea, author of a 5-vol. set on the Overland Campaign, whose latest is *Lee's Army on the Overland Campaign*.
