FINAL STATEMENT

VOLUNTEERS.

NOTE 1.—Two of these certificates (or duplicates) are to be given to each volunteer soldier who may be discharged previously to the discharge of his company, that he may at once receive from the Paymaster the pay, Ar. due him, and the captain or other officer commanding the company will certify to the act of the delivery of the duplicate certificate; on these certificates the Soldier is "entitled to" his discharge, and should also present his discharge to the Paymaster to have the payment reduced on it. The discharge is to be given back to the Soldier by the Paymaster, the latter only retaining as his voucher the duplicate certificate.

NOTE 2.—If the Soldier is entitled to pay for the use of his horse, the Company Quartermaster will certify to that fact, and also to the time he has pay due for having been so mounted on his own horse.

NOTE 3.—Amounts due the Soldier and Landress must be entered on the Muster Roll on which the death, desertion, &c., is reported, as well as on the final statement, otherwise the amount cannot be collected from the United States.

NOTE 4.—This blank will be used for deceased volunteers as well as others.

I certify, on honor, that David Burton a Private of
 Captain Cavan Thomas Company (4) of the 23rd Regiment of Ky Infantry
 VOLUNTEERS, of the State of Kentucky, born in Russell County State
 of Virginia, aged 21 years, 5 feet 7 inches high; Fair complexion,
Grey eyes, Black hair, and by occupation a Farmer, having joined the company on
 its original organization at Grayson Kentucky, and enrolled in it at the muster into
 the service of the United States at Louisia Kentucky, on the 10th day
 of January 1862, (or was mustered in service as a recruit, by Captain
J. P. Johns, at Grayson Ky, on the 25th day of October
 1861, to serve in the Regiment,) for the term of Three years unless sooner discharged
 and having served **HONESTLY** and **FAITHFULLY** with his Company in field & garrison
 to the present date, is now entitled to a **DISCHARGE** by reason of his death

He was in the engagement of Chickasaw Bluffs near Vicksburg Miss and his death was caused by a Rifle shot on the 27th Dec (1862)

The said Private David Burton was last paid by Paymaster
Major Smith to include the 31st day of August, 1862, and has
 pay due him from that time to the 27th day of Dec 1862; he is entitled to pay and subsistence for
TRAVELING to place of enrollment and whatever other allowances are authorized to volunteer
 soldiers, or militia, so discharged. He has received \$ 67 ⁸⁵/₁₀₀ dollars,
 advanced by the United States on account of **CLOTHING**.

 authorities for **CLOTHING, &c.**, received on entering service, _____ dollars; also,
 for expenses of **SUBSISTENCE** for **TRAVELING** from place of enrollment to the place of rendezvous,
