enlistment, capture or parole of a
man named James E. Hanger as a member
of any Virginia organization in the
Confederate Army.

However, in a letter on file in
this office dated March 26, 1862,
addressed to Hon. Jno. E. Baldwin,
Richmond, Virginia, James E. Hanger
of West View, Augusta County, Vir-
ginia, stated that he was wounded and
leg amputated in the battle at Phil-
lippi, and that if necessary as im-
propriety in a paroled prisoner tak-
ing a clerkship in the War Depart-
ment, he would like to have such a
position. The letter was referred
to the Confederate States War De-
partment. No further record relative
to him has been found.

Sir:

Referring to the communication addressed to you by this office on the 16th instant relative to the military record of James E. Hanger in the Confederate States Army, I have the honor to inform you that upon a reexamination of the official records the following additional information has been found therein:

The name James E. Hanger appears upon a list of prisoners of war with entries showing that the soldier was a private of Company D, 23d Regiment of Virginia, Confederate States Army; that he was captured at Phillippi

(date not stated), and that he was paroled and forwarded August 15, 1861, to Grafton, West Virginia.

The name Joseph E. Wanger appears upon a list of paroled prisoners of war at Beverly, Virginia, August 13, 1861, with entries showing that the soldier was a member of Company D, 23d Virginia Regiment, Confederate States Army.

Neither the name James E. Hanger nor the name Joseph E. Wanger has been found on the rolls, on file in this Department, of the organization mentioned, nor has any additional information concerning a man bearing either of those names been found in the official records.
