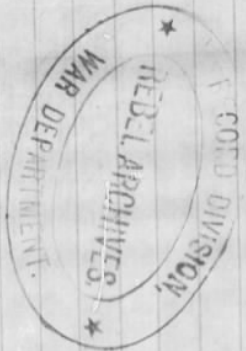

Brax. Com. of Conscripts for detail as producers &c. These parties therefore are that recruiting officers under General Order No. 88 have nothing to do with them. Such, too, is the case with many who have been dropped from the list of state troops.

The indiscriminate detail system adopted in Walker and Montgomery Counties leaves very little material for a recruiting officer to work on
