The 1st (also known as Gallard's and as the Charleston) Battalion South Carolina Infantry was accepted into the State service about February 17, 1862, and mustered into the Confederate States service in March, 1862. It was consolidated with the 1st Battalion South Carolina Sharp Shooters to form the 27th Regiment South Carolina Infantry, by S. O. No. 198, Dept. S. C., Ga. & Fla., dated September 30, 1863, this company becoming Company I of that regiment.
