




8:30 PM #3 The 45th New York goes into position on the left of the 102nd New York as the 82nd Illinois supports the 60th New York. **#15** Jones' Brigade retreats. **#16** The 23rd, 37th and 10th Virginia continue to move forward.




8:35 PM #3 The 23rd Virginia drives back Co. A, 137th New York, and goes into position on the left of the 1st Maryland.




8:40 PM #11 The 1st North Carolina halts its advance on the west bank of Rock Creek as the 37th and 10th Virginia continue to move forward. (The 71st Pennsylvania moves up Pardee field).




8:45 PM #2 The 71st Pennsylvania relieves Co. A, 137th New York, and goes into position at right angle to 137th New York but not physically connecting to it.




8:50 PM #1 Taking fire from front and rear, the 71st Pennsylvania falls back.




8:55 PM # 1 The 71st Pennsylvania retreats to Spangler lane as the 137th New York, is attacked on its front and unprotected right flank.




9:00 PM #1 The 137th New York starts to fall back; the 10th Virginia moves forward on the left as **#8** the 23rd and 37th Virginia move past the abandoned breastworks and the 1st North Carolina starts to move up in support. **#2** Neill's 6th Corps Brigade starts to go into position.




9:05 PM #1 The 137th New York launches a bayonet attack against the left flank of the 10th Virginia as it retires behind the traverse; the 149th New York starts to fall back while the 14th Brooklyn and 6th Wisconsin advance to the right of the line. #3 The 10th Virginia halts its advance.




9:10 PM #1 The 61st Ohio and 157th New York move to the right; the 149th New York moves back into line; the 14th Brooklyn and 6th Wisconsin advance past the 137th New York's right flank. **#6** The 10th Virginia changes position to the southern side of the stone wall facing west.



9:15 PM #3 The 14th Brooklyn halts as the 6th Wisconsin advances on its left and the 71st Pennsylvania starts to move toward the Baltimore pike; the 61st Ohio and 157th New York move to rear of the 137th New York; #12 The 1st North Carolina stops advancing; the 1st Maryland and the 37th and 23rd Virginia start to fall back into the 12th Corps' abandoned breastworks.



9:30 PM #5 The 14th Brooklyn moves back toward the right of the 137th New York as the 157th New York and 61st Ohio take position behind the 137th in two lines; the 6th Wisconsin occupies the stone wall; #15 The 10th Virginia falls back.



9:45 PM #3 The 14th Brooklyn returns to its old position as the 82nd Illinois moves to relieve the 149th New York; the 157th New York and 61st Ohio move from behind the 137th New York and take fire from the 6th Wisconsin in their rear and Confederates still occupying the breastworks. **#4** Kane's 12th Corps Brigade, 29th Pennsylvania leading, enters wood moving back to previously held breastworks.
