Dear Mrs. Howell:

This is in reply to your letter of 28 August 1952, herewith returned.

The records show that one George W. Varner, private, Company I, 6th Regiment North Carolina Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted 24 February 1862 at Orange. The company muster roll for November and December 1863, last on file, shows him absent, "Abs't prisoner since 7th Nov., 1863."

Union prisoner of war records show that he was captured 7 November 1863 at Rappahannock; imprisoned at Point Lookout, Maryland, where he was paroled and transferred to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, 24 February 1865, for exchange.

His name appears on a Hospital Master Roll of paroled prisoners, sick in 3d Division, General Hospital Camp Winder, Richmond, Virginia, which shows that he was paid 2 March 1865. No later record of him has been found.

This collection of records is by no means complete, and failure to find the entire record of Confederate military service does not indicate necessarily that an individual did not serve at some period not covered by the records.
